The Position:

ECC is seeking a full-time Children's Ministry (CM) Director to shepherd and oversee its children's ministry (elementary-aged children and younger). The position involves ministering at both the Seattle and the Edmonds campuses. The minister will work under the direction of the ECC elder overseeing CM, collaborate with the Redmond campus CM director and pastors in a team-based ministry approach to facilitate the overall children's ministry and vision, and provide overall cross-campus guidance/support for the two campuses (Seattle and Edmonds).

- Interface with CM volunteers, coordinators, and the pastoral staff in order to meet CM needs.
- Implement a campus-wide strategy for follow-up and outreach to children of new families, including visitations if needed.
- Oversee and organize annual summer VBS, KidzKlub on the 1st and 3rd Saturday evenings, and outreach events at the Seattle campus.
- Coordinate children's programs for any church-wide children's programs (e.g. Church-wide summer conferences).
- Organize quarterly/annual coordinator and teacher trainings across all campuses.
