### The Position:

ECC is seeking a full-time Youth Pastor or Minister to oversee the youth ministry (grades 6–12) based at the Redmond Campus. The main call of this role is to know, care for, and honor the youth of our community, helping to provide for them a safe time and place to think about and wrestle with questions of faith, with the hope that they will come to faith in Christ Jesus. The successful candidate will collaborate with other pastoral staff, particularly the youth pastors and ministers across all our campuses and all pastors and ministers at the Redmond Campus. We believe in a team-based ministry approach to facilitate the overall church mission and vision and provide overall direction to the youth ministry.

- We offer excellent medical/dental/vision insurance, PTO, and sick leave

### Responsibilities:

- Seek and cast God's vision for ECC-Redmond’s youth ministry for the next five years
- Address the continued growth and increasing needs of ECC-Redmond’s youth ministry
- Plan/develop youth curriculum and teach as needed
- Lead youth programs and activities
- Collaborate with youth pastors/ministers across campuses to build a unified ECC youth ministry
- Oversee youth Sunday school following the worship service

- Plan and lead youth worship and activities
  - Every Friday for middle school
  - Every 1st and 3rd Saturday for high school
- Build relationships with the youth through programs and personal engagement
- Mentor and support youth counselors and leaders
- Help recruit and develop volunteer teams
- Coordinate youth retreats, camps, service projects, missions trips, and milestone events
- Participate in cross-campus events such as joint praise nights
- Report monthly to the ECC-Redmond Joint Council
- Track attendance and follow up with families
- Maintain youth ministry roster and volunteer database
- Communicate with parents and staff about events, training, and protocols
- Attend scheduled pastoral, board, and ministry council meetings
- Participate in youth parent briefings and visitations as needed

### **Requirements:**

For Pastoral Candidates:

- Seminary graduate with a Master of Divinity degree from an accredited institution

For Ministerial Candidates:

- College or Bible school graduate with completed seminary coursework (option to pursue further studies supported)

### **Additional Qualifications:**

- Spiritually mature with a passion for discipleship, community, and evangelism
- Strong collaborative, interpersonal, and communication skills
- Organizational ability to coordinate complex ministries and cultivate volunteers
- Ability to counsel youth and parents on youth-related issues
- Understanding of Asian American cultural dynamics, including the unique challenges faced by youth from immigrant families and multi-generational church contexts
- Agree with ECC's Statement of Faith
- Eligible to be employed in the US and become a member of ECC
