- Pray for the Spirit to guide the inter-generational visioning conversations with leaders in the Chinese and English congregations, youth, and children's ministry toward unity and clarity.

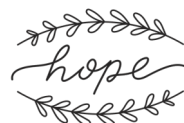
PRAY FOR OUR MISSIONARIES

Following God's calling, Minister Wendy Choy will be focusing her ministry on integrating biblical teaching with spiritual formation in discipleship training. Minister Wendy will be resigning from her role as Minister of the Redmond Cantonese Congregation (RED-C), effective June 30, 2026. The Elder Board has appointed Elder Sam Wan as Chair of the Pastoral Search Committee and is developing a ministry transition plan for the RED-C Congregation.
