Responsibilities:

- Pulpit Ministry: Coordinate/schedule and preach at the Cantonese worship service.
- Minister to the Cantonese congregation through visitations, counseling, and supervision of small group gatherings. (Note: Approx. one-third of the congregation is aged 60+, with an increasing number of young families.)
- Equip the Cantonese congregation for ministry, evangelism, and missions.
- Equip and train small group leaders.
- Share in the responsibilities of teaching Sunday school.
- Share in the responsibilities of campus and church-wide ministries.
- Collaborate with various ministries of the church as directed by the Elder Board and council.
- Administrative duties such as bulletin preparation in coordination with the church administrative staff.

Requirements:

- Commitment to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
- Agree with the ECC Statement of Faith and Statement of Marriage and Sexuality.
- Spiritually mature with a passion for teaching, preaching, caring, outreaching, and missions.
- Seminary graduate with a Master of Divinity or equivalent from an accredited institution.
- Five years of church-related ministry experience or equivalent, three years or more of pastoral experience preferred.
- Fluency in Cantonese and English, and proficiency in Mandarin preferred for general communication.
- Eligible to be an ECC member and to be employed in the US.

Additional Qualifications:

- A team player with effective communication, interpersonal, and organizational skills.
- Be relational and able to serve and collaborate with a Cantonese congregation from diverse backgrounds.
- Ability to be flexible and manage multiple tasks simultaneously with attention to detail.
- Familiar with both Chinese and North American cultures.
