That is the most they have ever had in each class! The school is placing a heavier emphasis on parent involvement and commitment this year and trying to ramp up parent-teacher communications. Please pray for that:

- The school would be a community of people (teachers and students) who champion one another and use kind words
- Students would grow in their desire to learn and work on hard things
- The Lord's joy and peace would be felt in classrooms this week
- Teachers' minds would have clarity with new students and try out new things in the classroom

### PRAY FOR THE WORLD

- Please pray for Ukraine as millions of citizens weather the bitter cold after the incessant Russian attacks that have crippled the nation's power grid.
