For 30 years, Mawo and Janet Abaya have trained and discipled church leaders in the International School of Evangelism to reach unreached people

groups in the nation of Nigeria, with a special emphasis on discipling Muslim Background Believers (MBBs). Looking back to last year, they see how God had protected them despite the persecution against Christians in Nigeria. None fell into the hands of bandits, kidnappers, or terrorists. The graduates, especially those who come from Muslim backgrounds, are actively winning souls, discipling the new believers, and sending them here for training. Most of the students in the current class are the harvests of their ministries. Young people who have attended training camps are growing in their faith. They share their faith with friends and encourage those friends to participate in training as well. Now Mawo and Janet have multiple generations of young people going through their camps and retreats.

- Please pray for the seemingly forgotten conflicts around the world, including Ukraine, Myanmar, and the Sudan. As with the war in Iran, may the Lord be gracious to comfort those who have suffered loss, be merciful to those who are trapped in the conflict zones, and grant courage to those who would be peacemakers to help warring parties reach a peaceful resolution.
