Since the cease-fire agreement was reached the day before their arrival, they were able to debrief and serve the staff and leaders instead. Many teams have inquired about coming to serve in Taiwan, and their

schedules are lined up until August 2026. Please pray for:

- Grace's safe travel to Malaysia. Pray for effective translation at the conference.
- The equipping of an outreach team from Tainan to the Philippines between 3/31 and 4/6.
- Fruitful outreach for teams from Montana, Amsterdam, and California.
- Preparation of Grace's team to train Taiwanese outreach teams for effective outreach in July.

- Please pray for the US Congress to reach compromise on many issues that affect our nation. May the Lord be merciful to the millions of air travelers throughout the country as they face hours-long delays and be gracious to DHS workers who are understaffed and working without pay for the past month.
