- The equipping of an outreach team from Tainan to the Philippines between 3/31 and 4/6.
- Fruitful outreach for teams from Montana, Amsterdam, and California.
- Preparation of Grace's team to train Taiwanese outreach teams for effective outreach in July.

- Please pray for the US Congress to reach compromise on many issues that affect our nation. May the Lord be merciful to the millions of air travelers throughout the country as they face hours-long delays and be gracious to DHS workers who are understaffed and working without pay for the past month.
