They wrapped up 5 weeks of a Thai parenting group and are mentoring another couple as they start another Mandarin-speaking one. Many of the participants are believers while some are not. Please pray for softened hearts. They also partnered with Athletes in Action to bring the gospel to one of the villages. They helped with minor construction projects, led a parenting workshop, held a soccer tournament, taught ultimate frisbee, and held a movie night showing Magdalene. 38 people received Christ! May the Lord bring pastors to help with the harvest from neighboring provinces.

- Please continue to pray for the impact of a rare "super El Niño" that is affecting much of Asia this summer. May the Lord be merciful to the areas that are experiencing flooding and gracious to those who have lost their livelihoods as a consequence of drought.
