Chang attributes the progress in his life—such as experiences of mercy, healing, and deliverance—to prayer support. Rev. Chang's central aspiration is for the Christ-centered community to foster mutual encouragement and resilience. He extends a cordial invitation to the Chinese Diaspora fellowship, offering his home as a venue for members to convene, share, pursue education, and grow collectively.
