Mawo and Janet Abaya – Urgent Prayer Request

For 30 years, Mawo and Janet Abaya have trained and discipled church leaders in the International School of Evangelism to reach unreached people groups in the nation of Nigeria, with a special emphasis on discipling Muslim background believers (MBB). They urgently request prayer for their campus in Jos and the surrounding community. Two weeks ago, innocent villagers in the community where their campus is located were killed by other herdsmen. A coworker's brother was also killed. The victims are mainly Christians, and the government has not taken any action to intervene. Pray that God provides supernatural protection and safeguarding, stopping further attacks. Also pray for comfort for believers who have long lived in fear, and grant Mawo's team strength and resources to bring Christ's love to vulnerable families affected by the crisis so that the name of Christ can be glorified.

Danny Geng serves overseas scholars at UW through China Outreach Ministry (COM), focusing on discipleship training and caring for students pursuing master's and doctoral degrees. COM's vision is to reach future leaders with the gospel, helping them not only believe in the Lord but also develop an intimate relationship with Him. In April, Danny traveled to San Francisco to introduce "Life Map" as a tool for campus ministry to build deeper relationships with students. He also led worship to support coworkers and students in their spiritual formation. Please pray for:

- Coworkers of multiple generations to serve together effectively in the H2O Fellowship at the EDS campus.
