Students are able to study His Word and obtain knowledge in good health and safety because of God's kindness and direction. Pray for two students who competed in an interschool solo singing competition, for them to gain confidence and experience God's presence, and for all the students at the center to be able to develop their spirituality and knowledge. Out of 30 students, only 12 can reside at the center while the rest attend school in their villages. Please pray for another vehicle to meet their transportation and delivery needs.
