The Position:

ECC is seeking a dynamic full-time English Pastor to shepherd and oversee the English congregation at its Redmond campus. The pastor will work under the direction of, and is accountable to, the ECC Elder Board and will collaborate with the other pastors in a team-based ministry approach to facilitate the overall church mission and vision; and will work closely with the Redmond-English Congregation Council and other co-workers to coordinate and administer an effective congregational ministry to proclaim the Gospel, care for its members, and facilitate their spiritual growth.

- Pay Range is \$77,000 - \$100,000 annually, depending on ministry experience.
- We offer excellent medical/dental/vision insurance, and PTO (Paid Time Off).
- We also offer a generous 403(b) retirement plan and tuition reimbursement.

Responsibilities:

- Work with the Redmond English Elders and the Redmond English Council in developing a comprehensive program that will develop and equip an individual from a seeker to a fully-committed, actively-serving Christian who exhibits Christ’s qualities.
- Pulpit Ministry: coordinate, schedule, and preach at the English worship services.
- Coordinate the English worship service and sermon series.

Requirements:

- Seminary graduate with a Master of Divinity degree or equivalent from an accredited institution
- Spiritually mature with a vision and passion for discipleship, outreach, and evangelism
- A team player with strong communication, interpersonal, and organizational skills
- Familiar with both Chinese and American cultures
- Has previous experience with ministry to primarily English-speaking college-aged congregants, young adults, and adults. At least five years of experience is preferred.
- Adheres to ECC's Statement of Faith and Statement on Marriage and Sexuality
- Eligible to be an ECC member and to be employed in the US

Accountability:

- The English Pastor reports to the Elder Board and communicates directly with the Redmond English Congregation Council.
- The English Pastor will observe ECC Pastoral Staff bylaws and work rules. He will actively participate on the ECC Pastoral Staff.
- The English Pastor, as with all pastoral and ministry staff members, is given the right and responsibilities to conduct ministry within the ECC community by the ECC Elder Board. The Elder Board (minus all employees of ECC – i.e., pastoral and ministry staff members) has the final authority to carry out all actions specified in the ECC Employee Handbook.
- Upon engagement, the English Pastor will be subjected to a one-year probationary period. The EB (minus all employees of ECC – i.e., pastoral and ministry staff members), with the recommendation of the English Ministry Council, will decide on the employment status of the English Pastor after that time.
