Dear sisters and brothers,

We have started the new 5-year preaching sermon series: Missional Discipleship. John 1:1–14 reminds us that we live in a spiritually dark world, and we need both light and sight—the light of Christ to reveal the truth and the sight to recognize who Jesus truly is. As disciples (followers of Jesus Christ), this is at the heart of missional discipleship: we are not the source of the light, but witnesses who help others see Jesus. Yet before we can point others to Him, we must be willing to come into His light ourselves—to be with Jesus honestly and humbly. We do not come to Jesus because we have cleaned ourselves up; we come because His grace meets us in our darkness and gives us new life. This does not mean we need to be perfect, but we need to humbly remain with Jesus, allowing His light to transform us.
